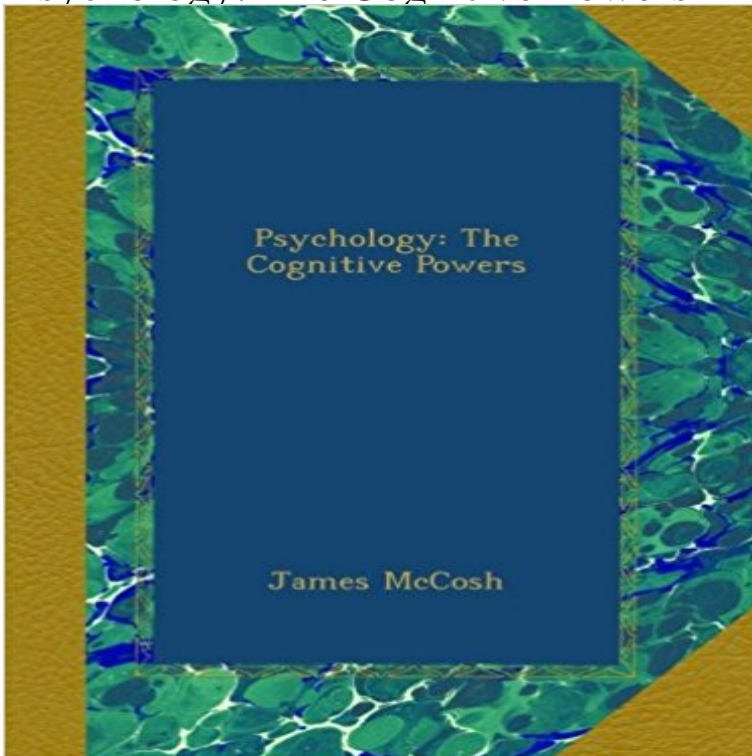


Psychology: The Cognitive Powers
