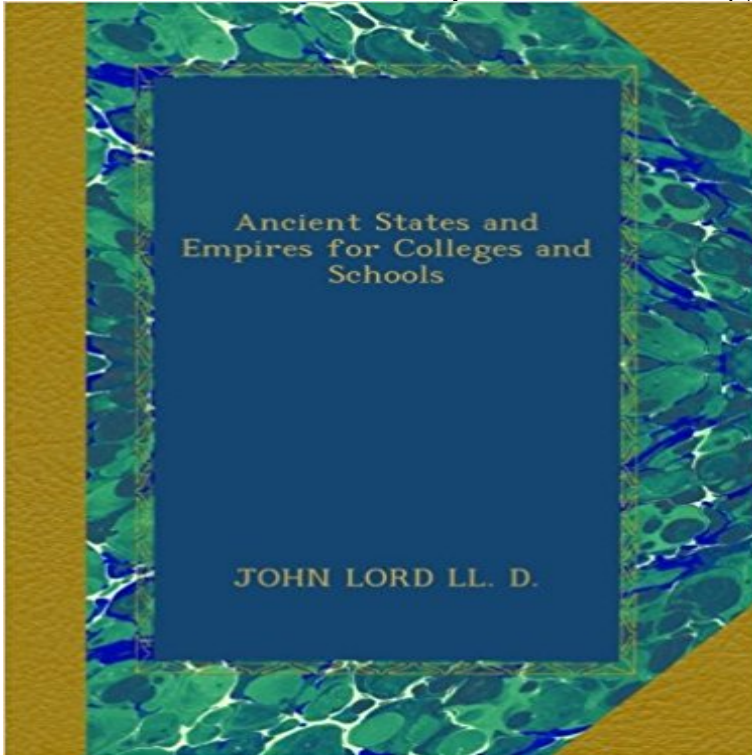


Ancient States and Empires for Colleges and Schools
