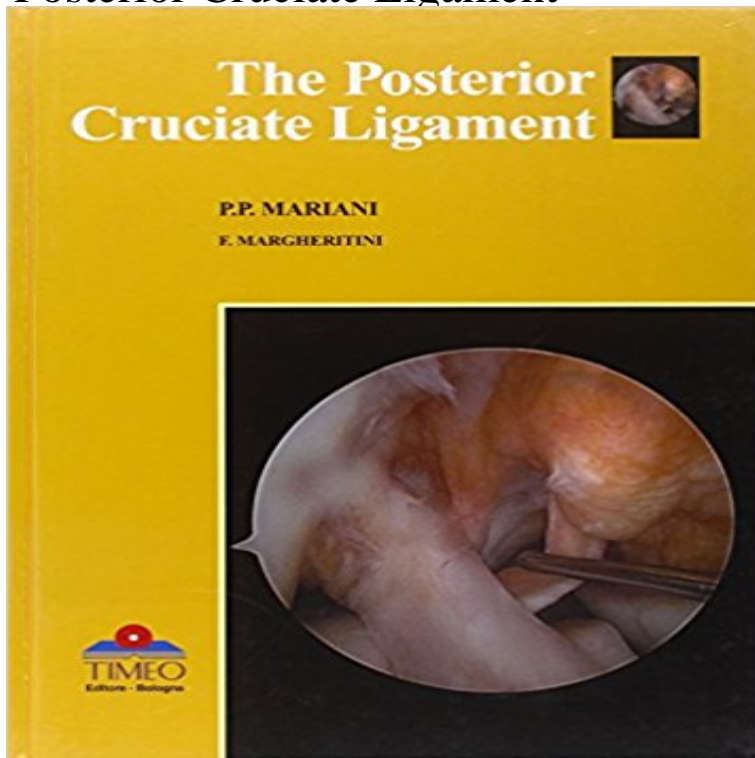

Posterior Cruciate Ligament (PCL) Injury - MoveForward The posterior cruciate ligament is located in the back of the knee. It is one of several ligaments that connect the femur (thighbone) to the tibia (shinbone).
