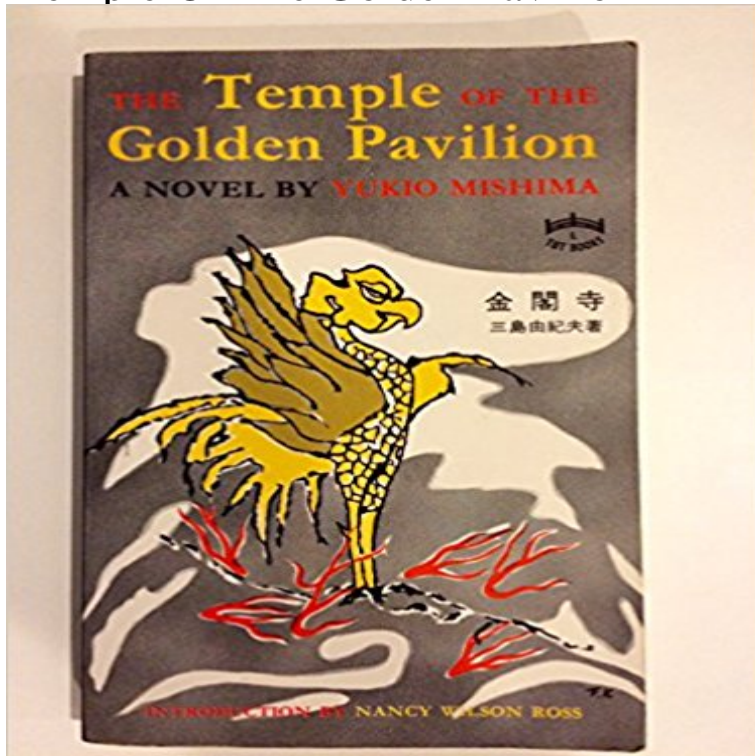


Temple Of The Golden Pavilion
