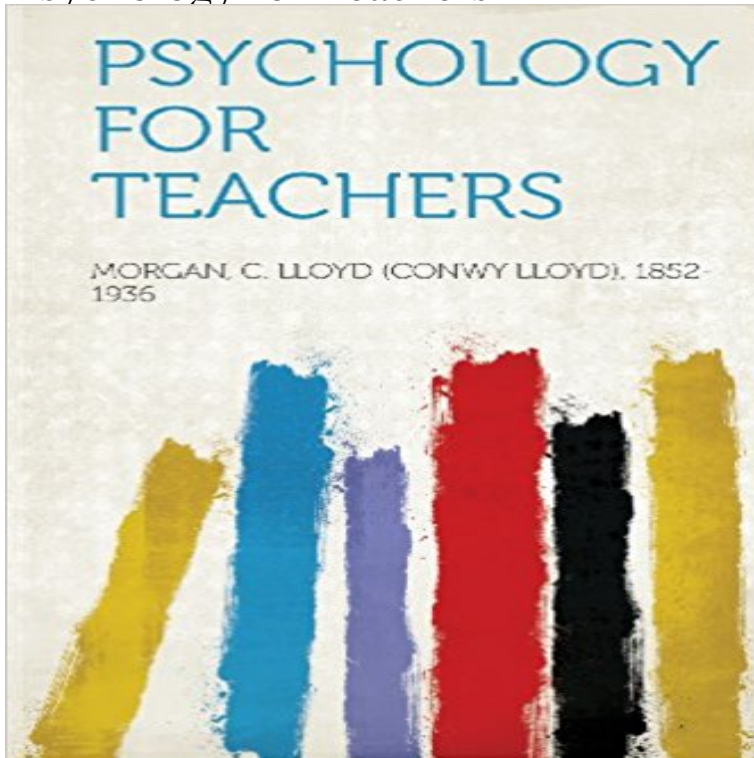


Psychology for Teachers
