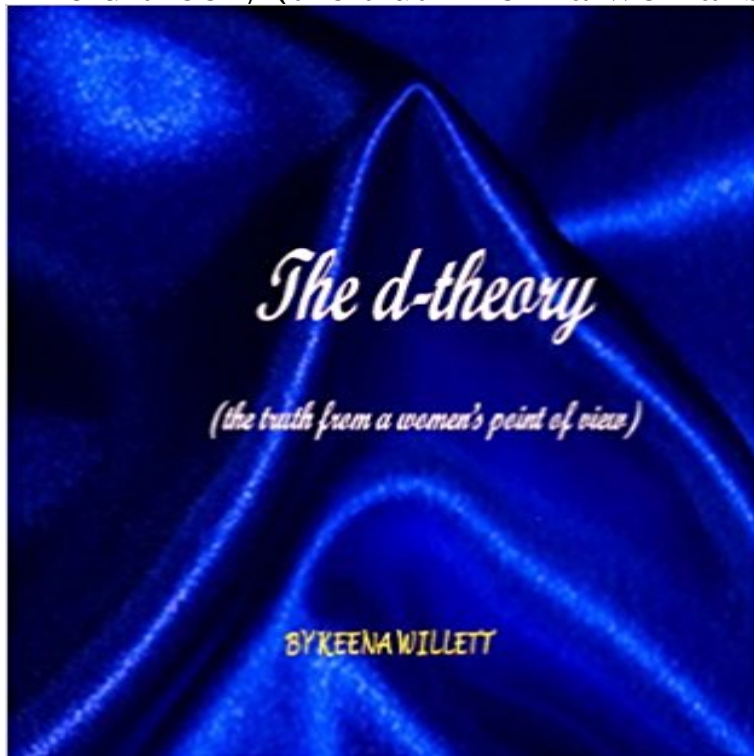


The d-theory (the truth from a womans point of view)
