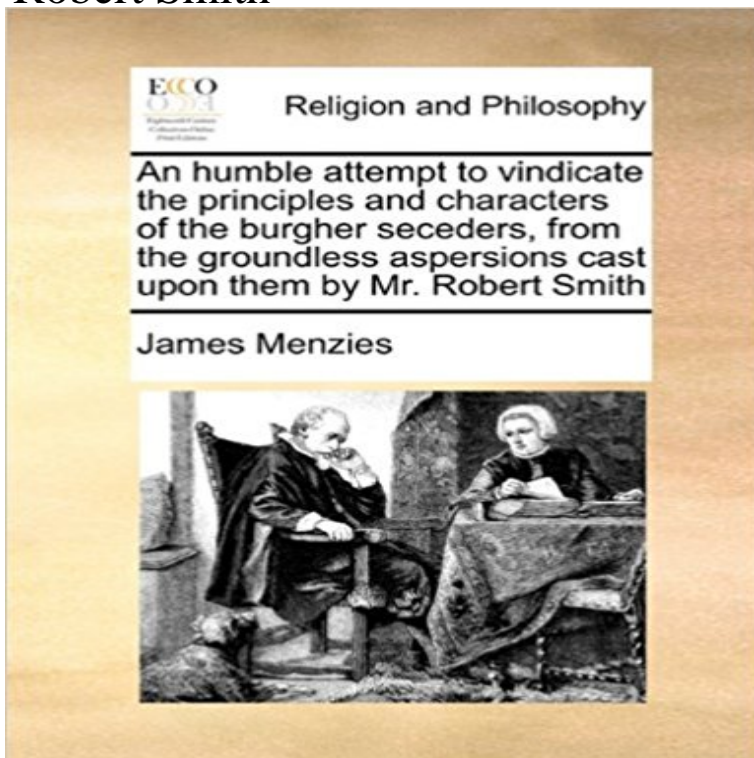


# An humble attempt to vindicate the principles and characters of the burgher seceders, from the groundless aspersions cast upon them by Mr. Robert Smith
