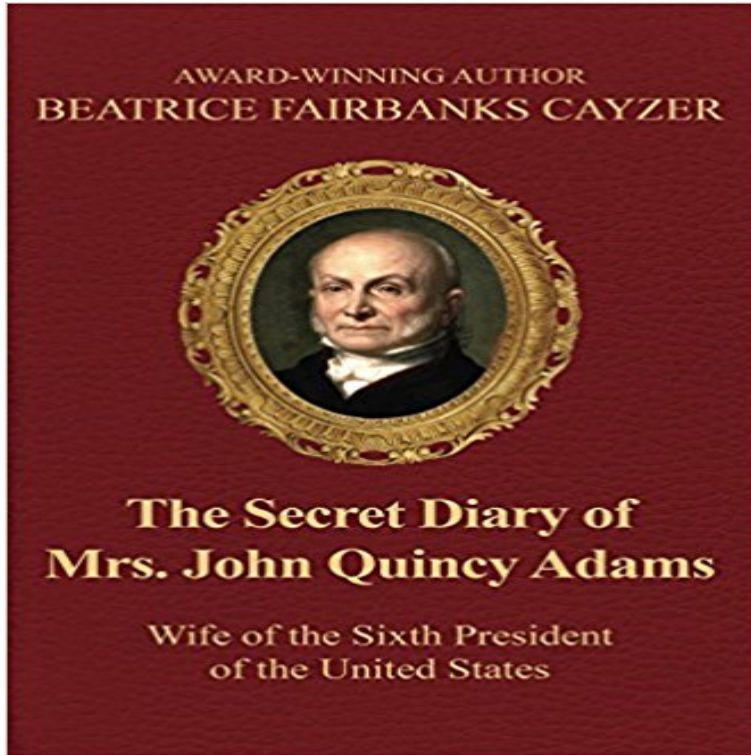


The Secret Diary of Mrs. John Quincy Adams: Wife of the Sixth President of the United States
