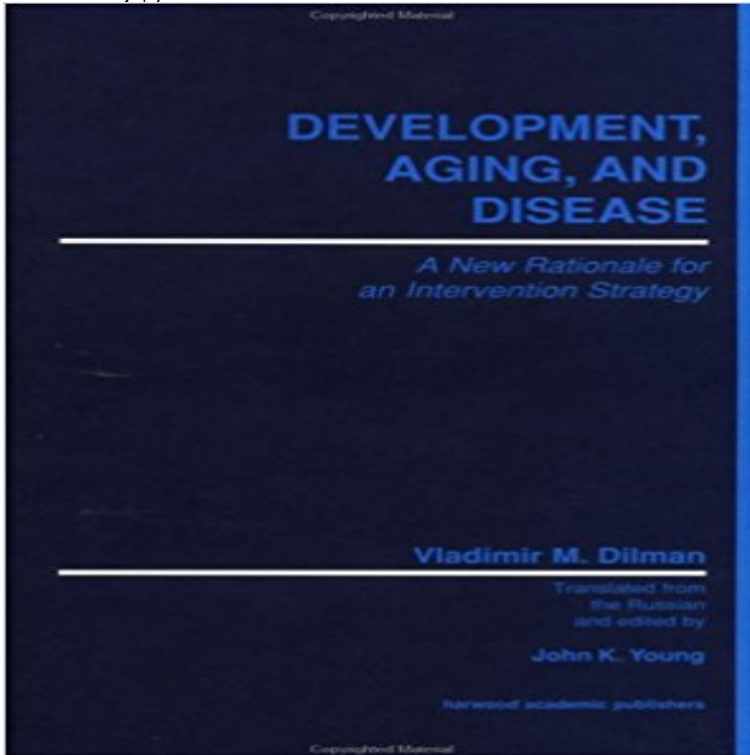


# Development, Aging and Disease: A New Rationale for an Intervention Strategy
