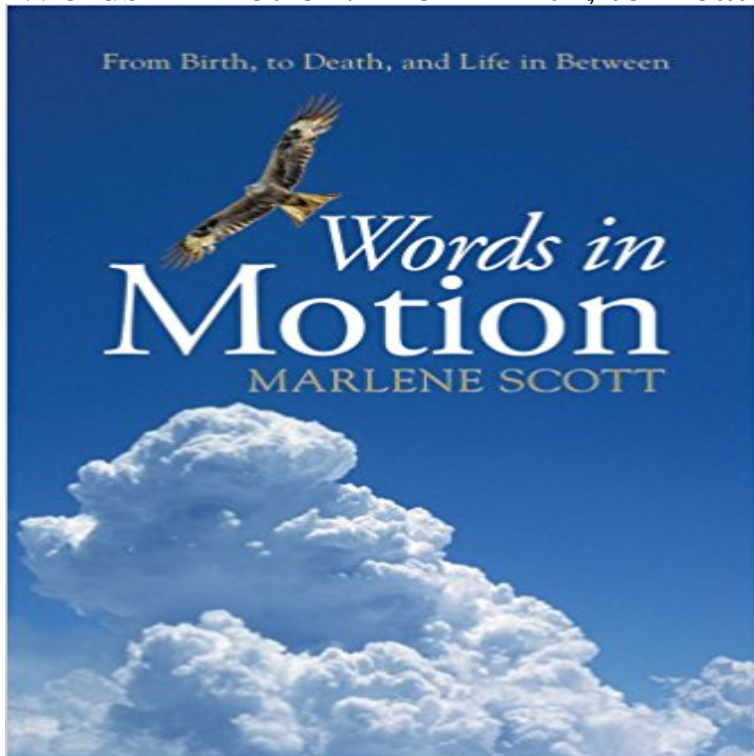


Words in Motion: From Birth, to Death, and Life in Between
