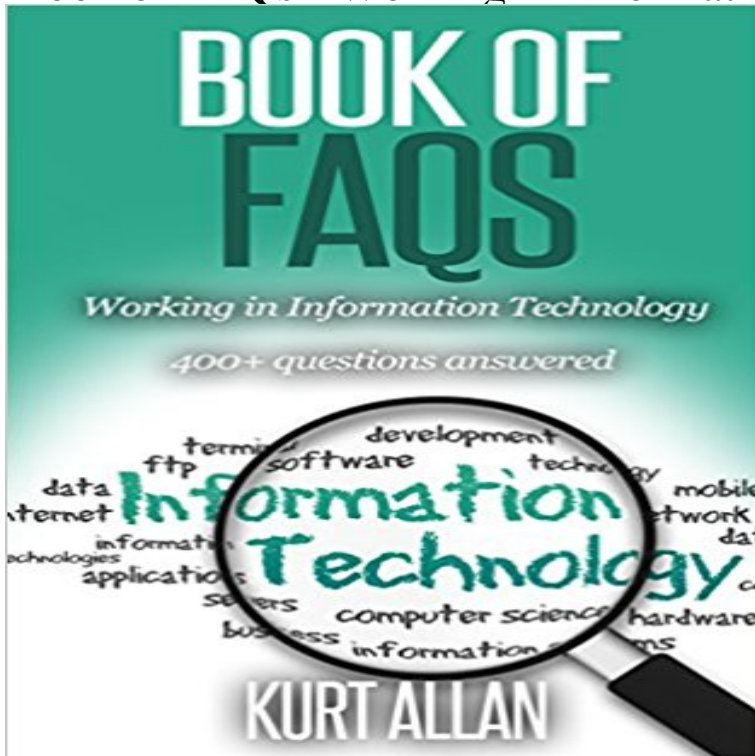


Book of FAQs - Working in Information Technology
