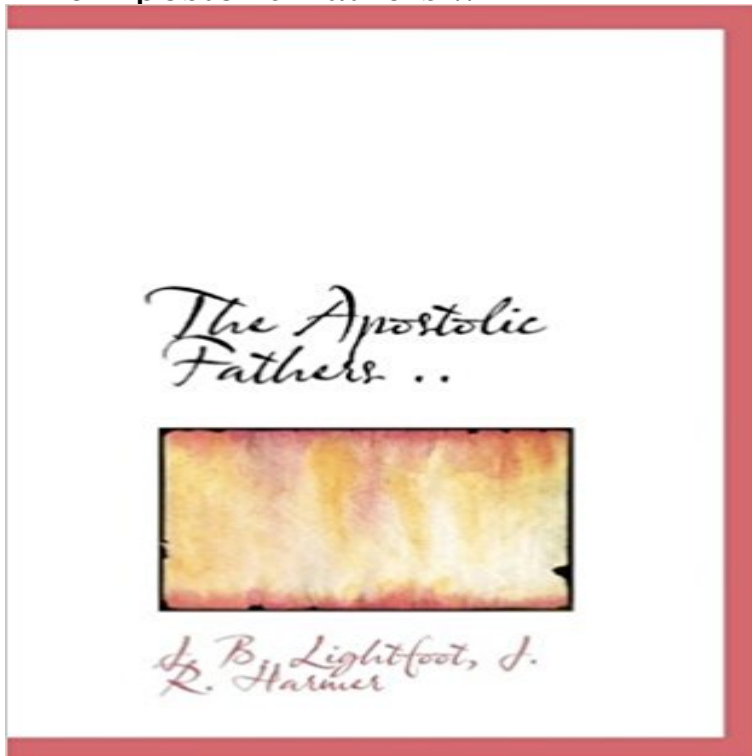


The Apostolic Fathers ..
