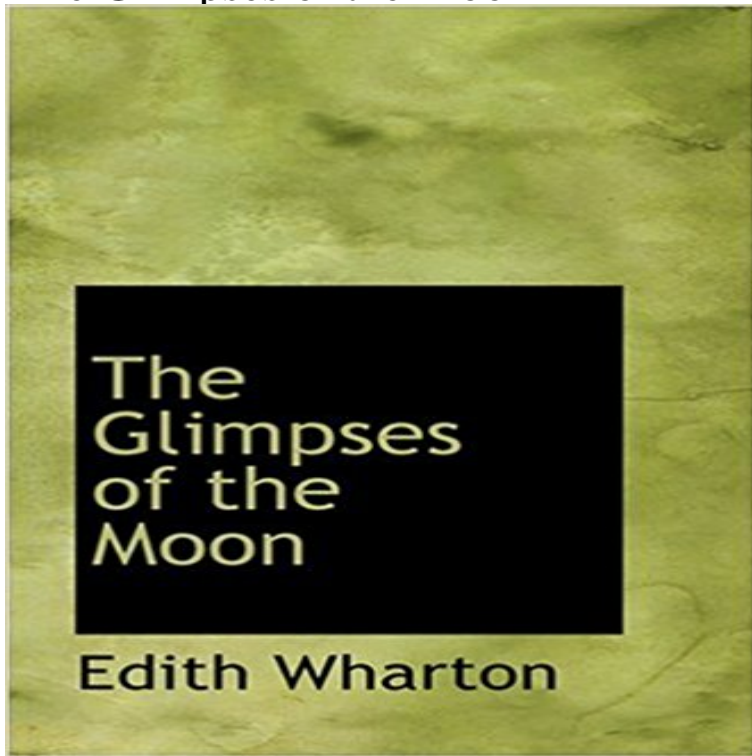


## The Glimpses of the Moon
