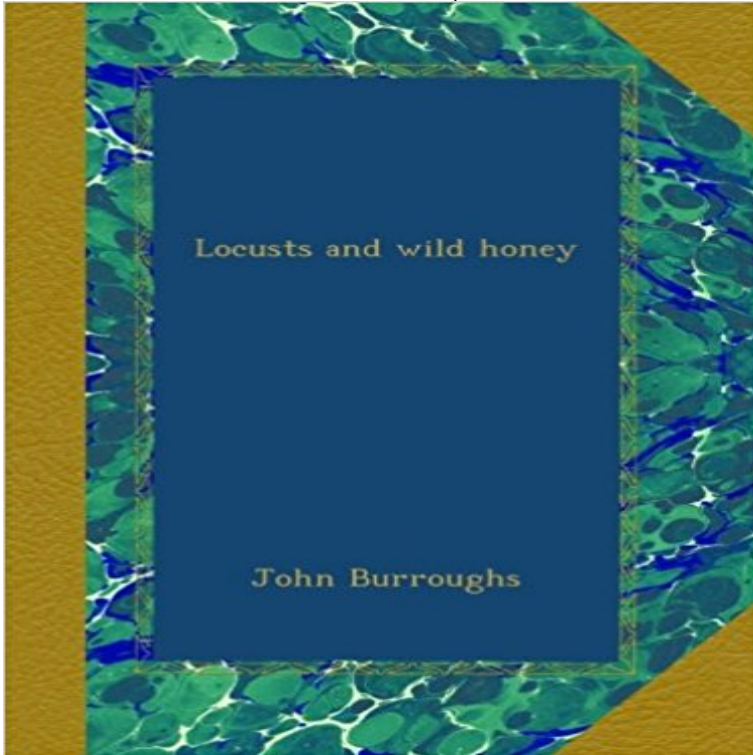


Locusts and wild honey
