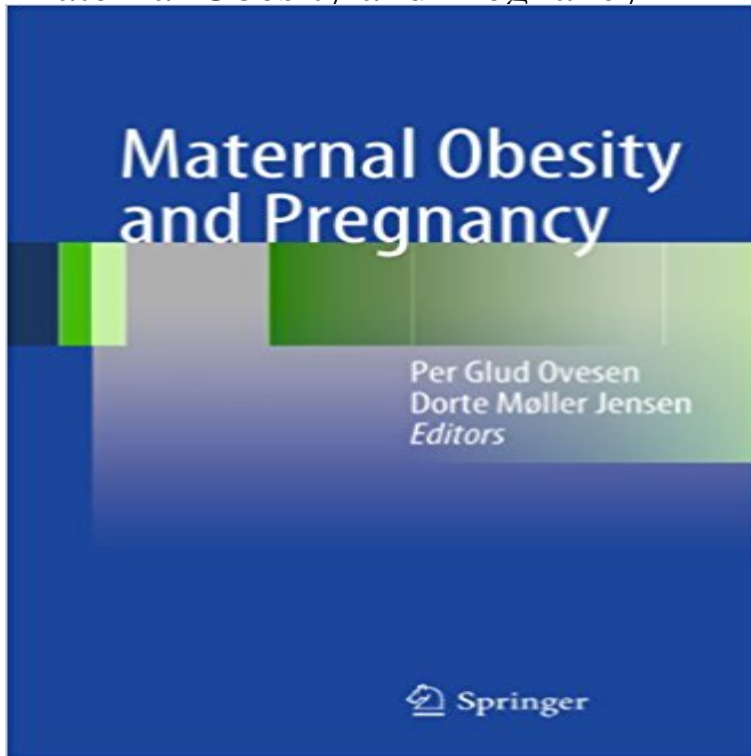


Maternal Obesity and Pregnancy
