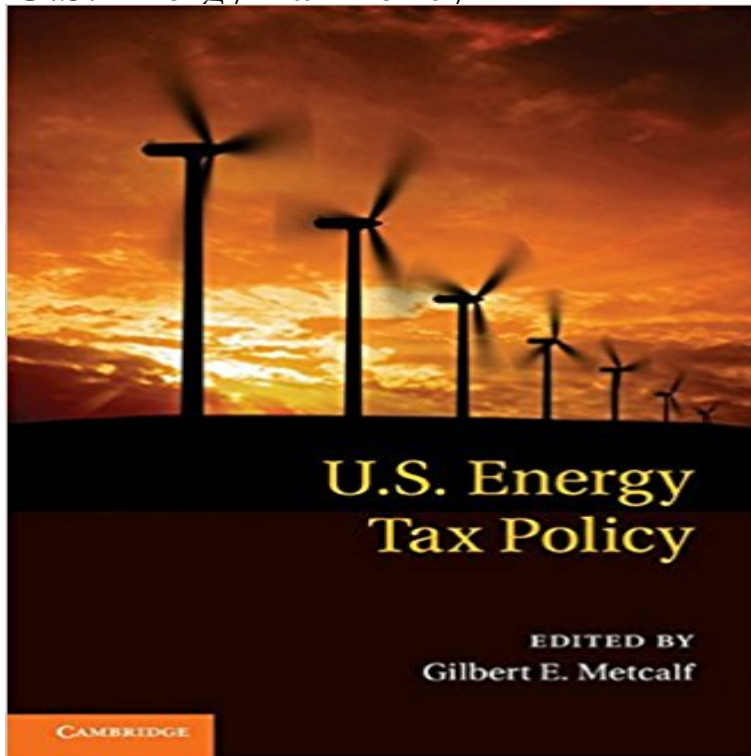


U.S. Energy Tax Policy
